## FOOTBALL

The Football Spires picked up their first conference win of the season on Saturday, Sept. 26, besting Southwestern College on the road, 49-7.

USM's record is now 1-3 on the year and 1-2 in the Kansas Collegiate Athletic Conference (KCAC).

The Spires have an open date this weekend. Their next game is USM's homecoming match-up against McPherson College at 1:30 p.m. on Saturday, Oct. 10.

## SOCCER

The Men's Soccer team notched a win over Central Christian College in USM's game prior to the KC Wizards match at Community America Ballpark Saturday. The Spires won 3-1.

USM's record now stands at 1-5 on the year overall.

Men's Soccer has three games this week—an away game at 4:30 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 29, against York College; a home match against Grace University at 4 p.m. Friday, Oct. 2; and the team's first conference game of the year, a home contest against Tabor College at 3 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 3.

Meanwhile, the women's soccer team battled to a 1-1 double-overtime tie against Central Christian in their game at Community America Ballpark Saturday.

The tie leaves the Lady Spires mark at 3-3-1 on the year.

The team plays again at 2 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 29, against York. They'll have their first conference game of the year at 1 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 3, as USM hosts Tabor.

## VOLLEYBALL

The Lady Spires Volleyball team went 1-2 at the Saint Ambrose Tournament on Friday and Saturday last week.

USM won their first match against Stephens College, 24-26, 25-18, 25-17, 25-23. They dropped their next two matches against Concordia University-Wisconsin and Missouri Valley College.

USM's record is now 2-11 overall and 0-7 in KCAC play.

The Lady Spires take the court again at conference opponent Southwestern College at 7 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 29.
